<b>City of Effie</b>	<p><b>Effie Streetscape Project:</b> This project will utilize Transportation Enhancement Funds to assist with the purchase and installation of a new sidewalk, lighting, and benches for the City of Effie.</p>	\$116,690	\$29,172	\$145,863	Street-scape
<b>Grand Portage Reservation</b>	<p><b>Grand Portage Reservation Trails:</b> This 1.3 mile trail system will connect residential areas to the Grand Portage Lodge, C-store, Marina, Heritage Center, Grand Portage Monument, and Tribal Council Offices. The trail will be non-motorized.</p>	\$300,000	\$75,000	\$375,000	Bike/Ped Trail
<b>Beaver Bay</b>	<p><b>Gitchi-Gami Trail Beaver River Bridge and West Road Segment:</b> This project will construct a segment of the Gitchi-Gami State Trail between Two Harbors and Grand Marais. This project will develop a bridge across the Beaver River, the Beaver Bay Trailhead Facility, and one mile of the trail.</p>	\$500,000	\$1,144,500	\$1,644,500	Bike / Ped Trail
<b>City of Duluth</b>	<p><b>Lakewalk East Extension Phase IV:</b> This project was funded as part of the 2011 Enhancements process. However, due to funding constraints for other projects in the MPO, the funding was reallocated to other projects. This project is an extension of the City's Lakewalk Trail beginning at 60th Avenue East, crossing Lester River on a new bridge and ending in the vicinity of Highway 61.</p>	\$500,000	\$200,000	\$700,000	Bike / Ped Trail
<b>City of Duluth</b>	<p><b>Lakewalk East Extension Phase V:</b> This project is an extension of the City's Lakewalk Pedestrian Trail. Phase V will consist of a 10 foot wide bituminous pedestrian trail beginning in the vicinity of Highway 61, crossing either under or over Highway 61 with a bridge/culvert, to the final termination at Brighton Beach.</p>	\$500,000	\$200,000	\$700,000	Bike / Ped Trail
